## Part 2 Planning

*This workshop will broaden the experience of those who were involved with Awakening the Spirit Within - Part 1 in September of 08. These 2 1/2 days will deepen the understanding of what is necessary to plan effectively for a person. It will be an event that will be focused and demanding. The presentations and planning will stretch your minds as you venture down the new path of what is possible.*

*Part 2 is only for those agencies who participated in Part 1 and it will be a time where we will actually plan for a person that you are working for. We will have facilitators present and will work with each team to come up with a realistic, self fulfilling and economically feasible plan with adequate safeguards.*

*Beth Mount and Pat Fratangelo will be present to float into each of the person's circle and assist each circle at this workshop in coming up with a down-to-earth and practical plan. Steve Smits and Max Chmura from OMRDD will attend and participate in the event.*

### **Who Should Attend?**

*Limited to only those agencies and staff who attended Part 1 along with the person they are planning for and the support circle that that person has. It is recommended that people who know the person most intimately be involved. A typical circle may include a person or persons who attended Part 1, person supported, administrative staff, family, and a significant person or persons in that individual's life.*

*The purpose of the event is for each circle to go home with a prepared plan personally developed for the person they are planning for.*
